As the regulations, guidelines and protocols related to COVID-19 are being constantly updated by all levels of government and their agencies, and by sailing organizations and Club's, such as QCYC, it's the responsibility of any sailboat participating in a Single Sailboat Self Time Trial to determine what applies at the time of their Single Sailboat Self Time Trial.

**The purpose is to encourage single sailboats of the QCYC Squadron to be sailing!**

**The end date is extended to Friday, August 7, 2020**

**The Details (Fine Print)**

1. What you need to comply with
  - 1.1. Participating sailboats shall comply with
    - 1.1.1. *Collision Regulations*<sup>1</sup> as currently enabled by the *Canada Shipping Act 2001*<sup>2</sup>
    - 1.1.2. Ports Toronto Bylaws, Rules and Regulations <sup>3</sup>

- 1.1.3. Transport Canada guidance on COVID-19<sup>4</sup> for pleasure craft at the time of the Single Sailboat Self Time Trial
- 1.1.4. All in place laws, regulations and orders issued by Province of Ontario, e.g.
  - 1.1.4.1. *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act (EMCPA)* <sup>5</sup>
  - 1.1.4.2. Replacement or follow-on laws, regulations and orders to related to the use of the EMCPA
- 1.1.5. In place orders and regulations issued by the City of Toronto
- 1.1.6. All QCYC Rules, Regulations <sup>6</sup>and *COVID-19 Protocols*<sup>7</sup> in force at the time of the Single Sailboat Self Time Trial
- 1.1.7. QCYC requirements for insurance coverage
- 1.2. The Single Sailboat Self Time Trial shall be conducted under the power of sail only from five minutes before the planned start until after the finish, i.e., no propulsion by mechanical or electrical means
2. Who can participate
  - 2.1. Open to any sailboat owned by a senior member in good standing and part of the QCYC Squadron
  - 2.2. Crewing can be single-handed to fully crewed. In the case of more than one person on board, the crew will be considered a gathering and orders in place at the time of Single Sailboat Self Time Trials under the EMPCA apply to the composition of the crew, gathering. All persons on board are considered, count, towards crew number.
3. When
  - 3.1. The sailboat may conduct the Single Sailboat Self Time Trial, at its convenience.
    - 3.1.1. Between Wednesday July 15, 2020 to **Friday, August 7, 2020 inclusive**
      - 3.1.1.1. Should any directive or regulation from the Government of Canada, including Transport Canada, Ports Toronto, Province of Ontario, City of Toronto or *QCYC COVID-19 Protocol* come into effect during these dates, the Single Sailboat Self Time Trial will cease immediately
      - 3.1.2. Start anytime one hour after sunrise and finish by one hour before sunset
    - 3.2. A sailboat may complete and submit more than one Single Sailboat Self Time Trial
4. Conducting the Single Sailboat Self Time Trial
  - 4.1. The Single Sailboat Self Time Trial Course is
    - 4.1.1. See page 3 – MARKS and **Figure 1** on page 4
    - 4.1.2. Sail option 1 or option 2
      - 4.1.2.1. Option 1: Start at Dufferin, Gibraltar (rounded to port), finish at Dufferin
      - 4.1.2.2. Option 2: Start at Gibraltar, Dufferin (rounded to port), finish at Gibraltar
    - 4.1.3. The round-trip distance is 3.09 NM

- 4.1.4. The course from Dufferin to Gibraltar is 296° Magnetic
- 4.1.5. The course from Gibraltar to Dufferin is 116° Magnetic
- 4.2. Timing, solely for single sailboat's own use
  - 4.2.1. Start: When the sailboat passes within 10 meters of the mark, with the mark to port of the sailboat and bearing to the mark is
    - 4.2.1.1. Dufferin: 026° Magnetic
    - 4.2.1.2. TE18: 206 ° Magnetic
  - 4.2.2. Finish: When the sailboat passes within 10 meters of the mark, with the mark to port of the sailboat and bearing to the mark is
    - 4.2.2.1. Dufferin: 206° Magnetic
    - 4.2.2.2. TE18: 026° Magnetic
  - 4.2.3. Timing is to be taken to the nearest second
- 5. Single Sailboat Self Time Trial Participation Submission
  - 5.1. Within 24 hours of the completion of the Single Sailboat Self Time Trial, the Person in Charge shall submit the following for each Single Sailboat Self Time Trial by email to [rearcommandore@qcyc.ca](mailto:rearcommandore@qcyc.ca)
    - 5.1.1. Information needed in each submission
      - 5.1.1.1. Name of the sailboat
      - 5.1.1.2. Name of the Person in Charge
      - 5.1.1.3. Which option sailed, 1 or 2
      - 5.1.1.4. Date & Time that the Single Sailboat Self Time Trial occurred
    - 5.1.2. Restrictions and caveats
      - 5.1.2.1. Maximum of two submissions for a sailboat per day
      - 5.1.2.2. Only information on one Single Sailboat Self Time Trial per email, i.e., each additional Single Sailboat Self Time Trial requires its own email.
- 6. Participation Posting
  - 6.1. All received Single Sailboat Self Time Trial submissions will be posted on [www.qcyc.ca](http://www.qcyc.ca) to provide transparency for the Participation Random Draw.
- 7. Participation Random Draws
  - 7.1. For each Single Sailboat Self Time Trial submission by a sailboat, the sailboat will receive one (1) chance for a random draw for one of three \$50 gift certificates for the QCYC Restaurant.
  - 7.2. The process for the random draw will be announced at a later date.

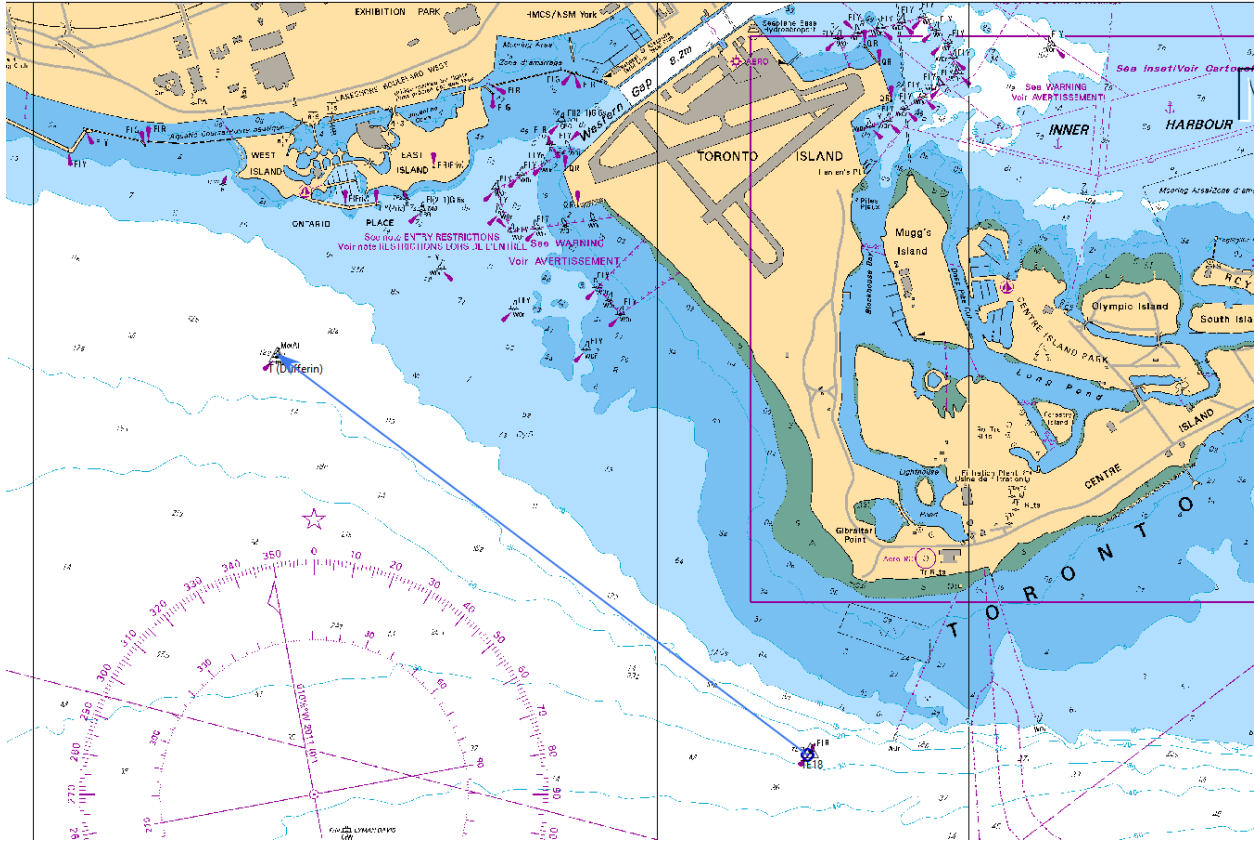
