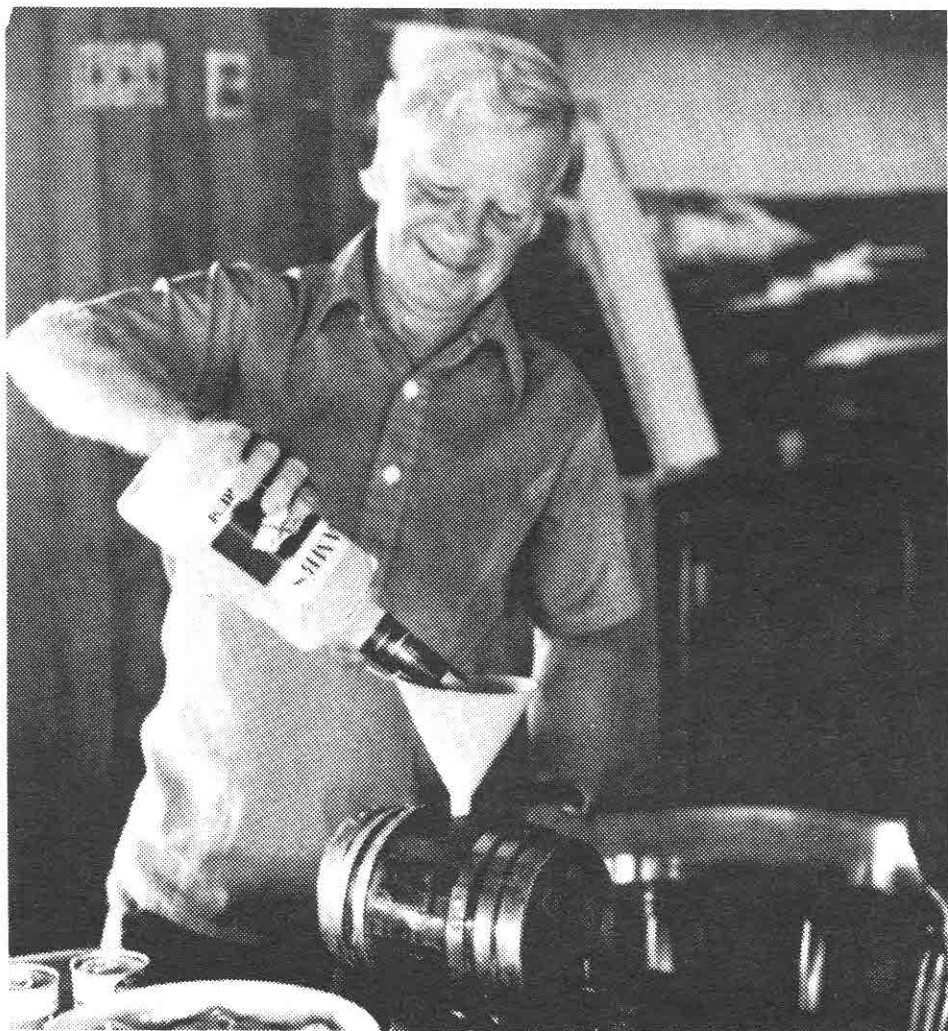

CREW MEMBERS ONLY:

b) Initiation Fee - \$50.00 ANNUAL DUES - \$190.00

May change to senior membership by paying initiation fee applicable at time of joining club less \$50.00.

NO VOTING RIGHTS

2. STUDENT MEMBERS:

Initiation Fee - Nil - ANNUAL FEE - \$50.00.

Must be taking recognized full time study course. Shall pay initiation when transferring to Senior membership, unless previously qualifying as an Intermediate member.

NO VOTING RIGHTS

3. INTERMEDIATE MEMBERS: (16 - 20 years (inclusive))

No initiation fee. ANNUAL FEE - \$50.00. NO VOTING RIGHTS.

May after 3 years transfer to Senior membership without initiation fee. Graduates of Junior Club may have the succeeding year's Intermediate membership free.

4. OUT OF TOWN MEMBERS:

Initiation Fee - Nil. ANNUAL FEE - \$25.00. NO VOTING RIGHTS.

Must not keep boat at Club. May be used to keep Senior membership open if member moved temporarily. Must reside at least 25 miles from Q.C.Y.C. Must pay initiation fee when transferring to Senior membership - if not a former Senior member. May not use the Club facilities on a regular basis.

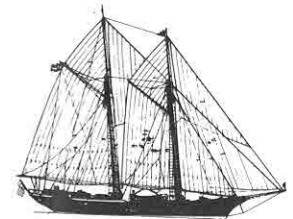
5. LATE APPLICATIONS:

New members joining after July 31st shall pay on the following scale:

After August 1st - Initiation plus \$60.00  
After September 1st - Initiation plus \$50.00  
After October 1st - First year's initiation only

LOCKERS, MOORINGS, BOAT STORAGE, ETC.

1. Lockers, Large (Annex) \$50.00 May be shared at \$25.00 / member.
2. Lockers, Large (Club) \$50.00 May be shared at \$25.00 / member.
3. Small Lockers \$50.00
4. New Lockers \$50.00 (All lockers billed on annual basis)
5. Dinghy Shed Lockers \$25.00 & \$20.00
6. Steel Clothes Lockers \$ 5.00
7. Wet Moorings \$100.00  
Keelboats over 30 feet - an extra \$5.00 per foot length only.
8. Marine Yard Storage  
Calculated at \$1.50 per foot, length plus beam; minimum charge \$50.00.
9. Dinghy Shed Storage  
\$100.00 annually. Winter only - \$50.00.
10. Dry Haul Storage (Outside)  
\$50.00 Annually. Starboats - \$75.00. Lasers - \$25.00.
11. Keelboat Summer Storage  
Same as winter storage rates.
12. Keelboat Summer Haul-Out  
\$15.00. Cross-Haul - \$10.00 extra.

CLUB HOUSE RENOVATION

Ron Mazza will characterize the structure of the building while Fred Mayerhoffer and Harry Altman will investigate the condition of the structure. The objective is to know by December 1, 1974 if it will be possible to renovate and or re-construct our club house.

Meanwhile Louise Barraclough, Jeff Turner, Len Canham and Con Lister are putting together a proposal or plan of renovation( on assumption that renovation is possible. It is hoped that more detailed comments can be put forth before the November Board Meeting, so that we could then modify plans to accomodate the Board's comments, opinions of Messrs. Mazza, Mayerhoffer and Altman and plan the next step.

WARD'S ISLAND WATER ( Chris Roberts )

Water hydrants which Metro Parks intended to install are delayed - perhaps for a long time. This really depends on the lease question.

DREDGING - LAGOON MOUTH ( Ron Hanley )

Metro want to dredge this Fall, because funding will cease at year-end. The problem at present is that environment people will not permit dredgings from inside the harbour to be placed outside the harbour. Metro is working actively on it now. Planning to pursue.
