The Review Ship is the Commodore's yacht, *Maddy Hatty*. The fleet will gather at the east end of the harbour at 1330 hours. At 1400 hours, the Fleet Captain will lead the fleet past the Commodore's yacht and will be followed by the Past Commodores, the Fleet and then the Rear Commodore.

The fleet will assemble in the marshaling area upwind of the Commodore's yacht. The Race Committee vessel, the *Harold S. Robbins*, will signal the start of the Review with a warning, prep and start signals at five-minute intervals, with the warning at 1350.
